

**TOWN OF CHRISTIANA**  
Minutes of the  
Virtual Special Town Board Meeting

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September 28, 2020 - 7:00 p.m.

The virtual meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Board Chair Maureen P. Lien. Among those attending were Board Supervisors Jim Lowrey and Jeff Notstad, Clerk/Treasurer Kathy Wilson, Public Works Director George Waag, and Cindy and Mike Cutrano.

**PROCEDURAL**

**OLD BUSINESS**

**NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Discussion/possible action regarding the purchase of a new snowplow truck.  
The Town received bids from I-State (\$106,066) and JX Peterbilt (\$106,740). Public Works Director George Waag recommended accepting the proposal from JX Peterbilt because of that truck's features.

*Board Chair Maureen Lien made a motion to accept the proposal for a new snowplow truck from JX Peterbilt for \$106,740. Board Supervisor Jeff Notstad seconded the motion.*

**The motion passed 3 – 0.**

*Board Supervisor Jeff Notstad made a motion to approve the proposal from Burke Truck and Equipment for the snowplow and other equipment to be added to the new truck. The first half of the total payment of \$83,358.55 will not be due until January, 2021. Board Supervisor Jim Lowrey seconded the motion.*

**The motion passed 3 – 0.**

- b. Discussion/possible action regarding information from the recent Dane County Towns Association meeting.

Board Chair Maureen Lien informed the Board that any funds left over from our Town's Routes to Recovery grant allocation may be given to the Cambridge Volunteer Fire Department.

- c. Discussion/possible action regarding a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day.

E-Cycling is provided on an annual basis in Deerfield, but would probably be prohibitively expensive for our Town. Board Chair Maureen Lien will investigate further when she discusses ongoing issues with Advanced Disposal representative Jason Johnson.
