Minutes of the Special Town Board Meeting

May 6, 2021 – 9:00 a.m.

The Special Town Board Meeting was called to order at 9:06 a.m. by Board Chairman Mark Cook. Those also attending were Board Supervisors Jim Lowrey and Jeff Notstad, Attorney Eric Larson, and Clerk/Treasurer Kathy Wilson.

PROCEDURAL

The meeting had been properly noticed and posted.

NEW BUSINESS

Board Supervisor Jim Lowrey made a motion to go into CLOSED SESSION pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 19.85(1)(g) Conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, concerning possible legal challenges arising from the application filed by Invenergy with the Wisconsin Public Service Commission to conduct a large-scale solar power operation in the Town of Christiana. Board Supervisor Jeff Notstad seconded the motion.
